Celebrating Milestones: We took center stage in celebrating MTAM's 50th anniversary, a testament to our long-standing tradition of excellence and service.




Community Engagement: Our "RMTs



2023 RESEARCH INITIATIVES

Enhancing Knowledge and Practice

In 2023, the MTAM Research Committee spearheaded significant initiatives to foster knowledge and improve practice among our members:

Educational Webinars: Introduced two pivotal webinars, accessible in the Member Portal:

- Fascia Research Congress Highlights:
 Presented by Jeffrey Dalhouse, this session brought insights from the international Fascia Research Congress to our members, enhancing understanding of current findings in fascia research.
- Evidence-Informed Communication: Anna Hovland led a session on using language that reflects the evidence in massage therapy. This included alternatives to commonly used terms, ensuring our communications are more aligned with current research.

Massage Therapy Summit: 2023 marked the relaunch of the Research Symposium as the Massage Therapy Summit. This event promises to bring new presenters and exciting discussions to the forefront of massage therapy research.



2023 ADVOCACY INITIATIVES

Championing for Our Profession

MTAM remains steadfast in advocating for the massage therapy profession, engaging in several key activities:

Insurance and Reimbursement: At the

Canadian Life and Health Insurance Association conference in Winnipeg, we engaged with insurance representatives to strengthen and forge new relationships, advocating for better massage therapy coverage and reimbursement.

Regulation Efforts: Continuously working towards the regulation of massage therapy in Manitoba, we keep the Health Minister updated on challenges faced due to the lack of regulation and engage in surveys with political parties to understand their stance on regulation.

Collaboration with Healthcare Associations:

Regular meetings with the Manitoba Healthcare Professional Association Coalition (MHPAC) help address common issues and advocate for the interests of healthcare professionals in Manitoba.

National Presence and Collaboration: Our involvement with the Canadian Massage Therapist Association (CMTA) ensures a national voice for our members. Efforts include working towards the removal of GST/HST from massage therapy treatment fees and collaborating on insurance and research initiatives.

Our dedication to research and advocacy not only supports our members but also advances the massage therapy profession both provincially and nationally.
